

## Welcome to your Training Course!

### Class Location

- **2nd Fife Scout Hall, Berrylaw Place, Dunfermline, KY12 8AL**  
Parking is available opposite the residents' garages at the end of the road.  
The Scout hall is located in the adjoining field.

### Our Training Approach

- We believe in **fun, reward-based learning** — because it works.  
Our aim is to help your puppy learn how to thrive in our world while still enjoying life as a dog.  
We never use or condone intimidation or punishment.
- **Your commitment matters** — attending each class, using your online resources and practising daily will help you and your dog make amazing progress together.

### Class Details

- Each class lasts **around one hour**, indoors (with some outdoor work when weather allows).
- All family members are welcome.
- Please arrive **5 minutes early** to help your puppy settle.
- Keep your dog **on lead at all times**, unless a trainer advises otherwise.
- Please respect space around other dogs and handlers, especially when entering and leaving.

### What to Bring Each Week

- Part of your dog's usual meal (serve the rest at home as normal).
- Several types of **food rewards** (for example, tiny pieces of cooked meat, cheese, or cubed JR Pate).
- A treat pouch that clips to your waist or fits easily in your pocket.
- Your puppy's **favourite toy** (no squeakers please and balls should have a handle).
- An **edible chew** or food-filled toy (for example, a Kong™).
- A dog towel.
- Water and bowl.
- Your dog! Wearing:
  - a **flat collar** and walking-length lead
  - a well-fitting **harness** if they pull (we recommend Perfect Fit or Ruffwear)
  - *No retractable or slip leads, please.*

### What We Provide

- Seating for handlers
- A mat for your dog
- Equipment for training games
- Goodie bag at your first session

## Children at Class

- Children are very welcome!
  - Under-16s must be accompanied by an adult.
  - If you have children under 8, please bring another adult to supervise so you can focus on training.
  - Children must ask a trainer before approaching another dog.
